General Information

- All testing appointments begin promptly at **9:00a.m.** and should be completed between 1-2pm, much like a school day. Please plan to arrive at our office by **8:45 a.m.**
- Your child will have breaks as needed throughout the day.
- Please bring for your child: snacks, a lunch, and drinks.
- If your child takes any regular medications, discuss this with your neuropsychologist prior to your examination appointment.
- If your child wears glasses or hearing aids, please bring them to your appointment.
- If your child is **8 or younger**, an adult must remain at the office for the full-day. If your child is **9 or older**, it is preferred that you stay.
- Our office has Wi-Fi access for your convenience.

How To Prepare Your Child for the Appointment

- Get plenty of rest the night before.
- You may tell your child that he or she will be going to spend the day doing different activities, such as drawings, puzzles, and stories. This is a special doctor who wants to find out how you think and solve problems.
- Assure your child this is not a pass/fail test and to provide his/her best effort to gain the most accurate results.
